## Fort Worth's Fourth

An evening of free music and family activities on the Trinity River behind LaGrave Field

Turn back time to an evening of good old-fashioned fun this 4th of July. Live music, water shows, trolley rides, games & activities will casually sprawl along the Trinity River on the levee behind LaGrave Field. The evening will end with what promises to be the best fireworks display in Fort Worth.

Fort Worth's Fourth is a free event open to the entire community. It is a gift given to recognize this important holiday, and to offer a unique venue for its celebration.

Live music will be provided by the Rock the Fourth Battle of the Bands, sponsored by 95.9 The Ranch. Stage performances will feature the three bands selected as finalists by radio listeners throughout the month of June. The winning band will play at Ranch Bash 2010.

This year's celebration features two new events.

- The Great Texas Hill Slide will capture the enthusiasm of levee sliding with a world record attempt for the most people sliding down a hill at one time.
- Float the Fourth offers cool water fun in the Trinity River, so a swim suit and towel will be important items for the day.

Games and activities will include water wars, splash pads, pony rides, bounce houses, treasure dig, and levee slides. Jet ski shows, and kayak rides, and trail tours by the

Shriners' Trolley will add to the entertainment as well.

The Fort Worth Cats will play ball at 4:35 p.m. All Fort Worth's Fourth guests are invited to watch the game from levee lawn seats.

Picnic baskets of food are welcome, but guests may not carry in alcoholic beverages.

Carefully selected vendors will be available to sell traditional summertime food, cold drinks, beer, and ice cream.

Plenty of water and cold watermelon will be provided. Lawn chairs, blankets, and pop-up tents are recommended to add comfort to the day.

The event will open at 4:30 p.m. Fireworks will begin after The Cats game, estimated to be about 9:30 p.m. Fort Worth's Fourth will close for the evening when the fireworks end.

Parking is available for a fee of \$5.00 at LaGrave Field, and free along the street west of N. Main Street.
