The Tarrant County Back To School Roundup free event will provide school supplies plus free dental, health and vision screenings; immunizations; haircuts; information and services; and more for Tarrant County children

Due to the growing need and last year's huge turnout, for the first time ever **families will be required to have pre-registered by July 30**, if they want to attend the Tarrant County Back To School Roundup, presented by Walmart and Sam's Club. This year's seventh-annual event is slated for Wednesday, August 10, 2011, from 8 a.m. – 2 p.m., at the Will Rogers Memorial Center's Amon Carter Exhibit Hall in Fort Worth. Parking is \$5 at the Memorial Center, or parking is free at Farrington Field, located at the corner of University and Lancaster.

"We really want to stress that **families must pre-register by July 30** and meet eligibility requirements to be admitted to Roundup and to receive free school supplies. **We will not be accepting walk-ups the day of the event,**" said Roundup executive director Judi Ketchum.

The Tarrant Area Food Bank reports that one in five children in Tarrant County live in extreme poverty and many families not only struggle to put food on the table but are unable to provide the essential school supplies and services for their children to start the school year prepared to learn. To make it possible for children to enter school this year prepared, Roundup will provide free school supplies to students pre-kindergarten through 12th grade who meet specific eligibility requirements. In addition, pre-K through 5th grade students will receive a free backpack. Roundup also will offer parents and children a wide range of education, health and social services.

Roundup is entirely funded by private donations and in-kind contributions. It is a collaborative effort between Tarrant County and its 20 school districts, its municipalities, public health department, state agencies, nonprofits, corporate sponsors and volunteers.

Students will benefit from a number of free services at Roundup including immunizations; dental screenings, fluoride varnishings, toothbrushes and toothpaste; vision screenings; and haircuts. All family members are welcome to take advantage of free health screenings (including blood pressure and glucose) and services. Other

highlights will include musical entertainment, kids activities, games, interactive demonstrations and other school-spirited activities.

An abundance of educational information, in English and Spanish, will be offered at community resource booths focused on literacy, parenting, nutrition, financial literacy, fire safety and social services. Representatives from Tarrant County schools will be on hand to answer questions and distribute all kinds of information on reading programs, psychological and social services, and family literacy.

IMPORTANT: Free school supplies are available only to those who are pre-registered and meet specific eligibility requirements (must be public school students ages 4-18 who reside in Tarrant County and meet the 2011 Federal Poverty Income guidelines). **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE A PHOTO ID, PROOF OF TARRANT COUNTY RESIDENCY AND PROOF OF INCOME SHOWING THE FAMILY FALLS BELOW THE POVERTY LEVEL.**
