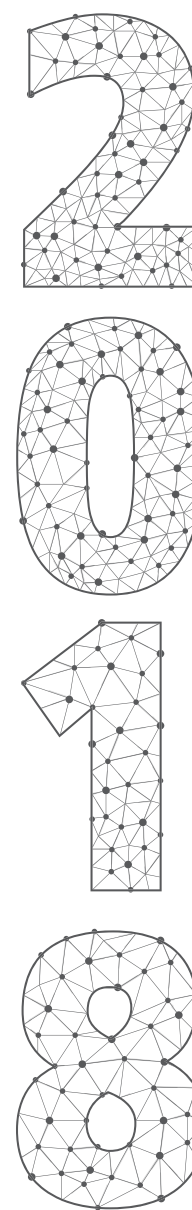
* HAPPY NEW YEAR!

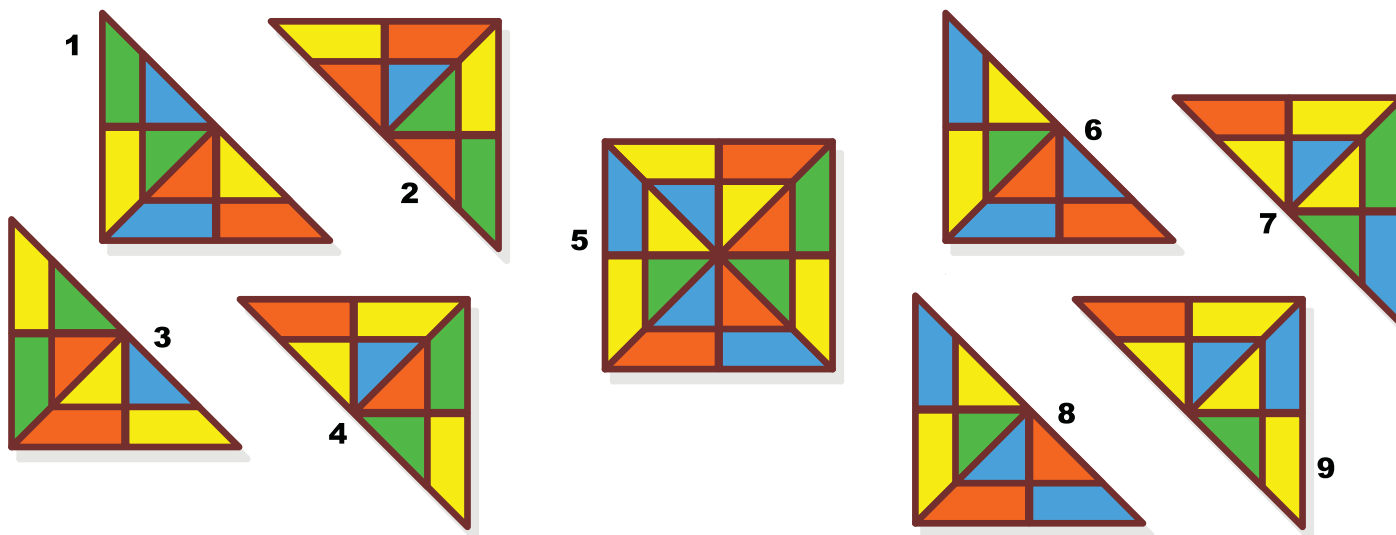
New Year's Facts:
