Visitors will be able to browse a large farmers market featuring local vendors, including the community's own Harvest Green Veggie Wagon, as well as enjoying tunes spun by a DJ, a rock wall, a pumpkin patch, animal adoptions and farm tours. During the tours, people will have an opportunity to learn more about the growing of such Thanksgiving staples as pumpkin, corn and squash. Afterward, they can take pictures with the farm's tractors. Children will enjoy a meet and greet with Harvest Green's chickens and Nubian goats. Other activities will include pumpkin decorating for kids, bouncy houses, face painters, balloon artists, a pie-eating contest and harvest games such as bobbing for apples and searching for needles in a haystack. 


